Children's Rights Day November 20th is dedicated to children as it is the day of the declaration and signing of the Convention on the Rights of the Child by the UN General Assembly on 20 November 1989.

The 54 Articles of the Treaty refer to children's rights and were ratified by 193 states. In Greece, the Convention was ratified on 2 December 1992 by Law 2111/92 and includes three major categories of rights:

- ☐ Protection (from all forms of abuse, exploitation, discrimination, racism, etc.)
- ■Benefits (right to education, health, welfare, entertainment, etc.)
- Participation (right to expression of opinion, information, leisure time, etc.).

Against Women

November 25th has been established by the United Nations as the world day of eradicating violence against women. One in three women will face physical, psychological or sexual violence at a certain time in her life, while every year in the 27 Member States of the European Union, 3500 women die of domestic violence.

The 1st EPAL of Drama held an event during which the students watched:a) video presentation on violence against women around the world, and b) research presentation regarding the victims of violence in Greece .Finally,the students created posters and collages.



The Universal Declaration of Human Rights, the most important recognition of the rights and freedoms of all people, was adopted on December 10, 1948. Since then, this day has been celebrated worldwide as the Day of Human Rights. Its formal adoption took place on 4 December 1950 by the General Assembly of the United Nations. The vision of its inspirers was a world free, fair and peaceful without any trace of discrimination. Human rights belong, without exception, to all people.

In 2014 the slogan of the celebration was: "Human Rights 365". That is, every day is a day of human rights.







Immigrant Day


December 18 was proclaimed by the United Nations as World Immigrant Day, in an effort to strengthen the UN campaign to protect the migrants.
