

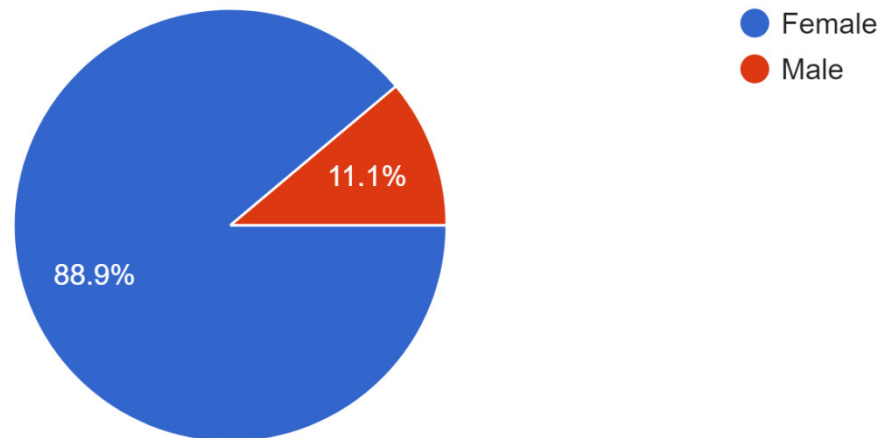

### 1. Gender

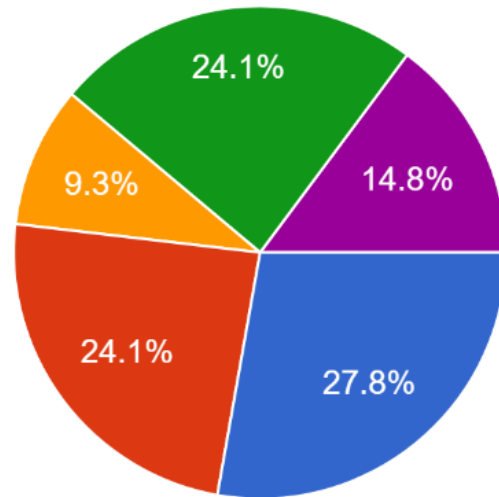
54 responses

54 responses

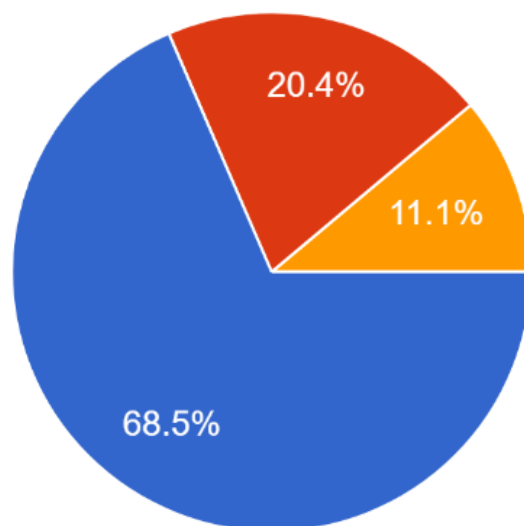


- Greece

54 responses

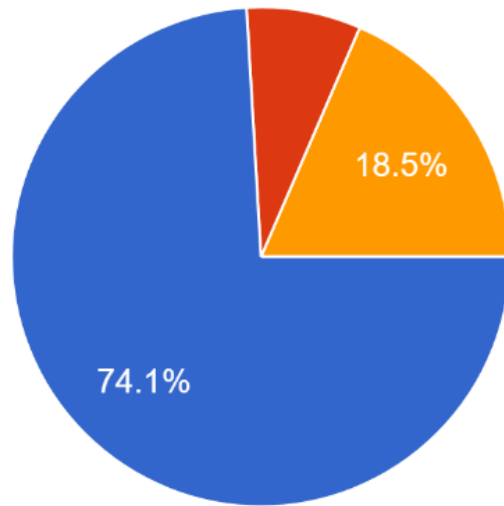


- You've always loved crafts and kids—you decide to get an arts class going for some needy kids.

54 responses

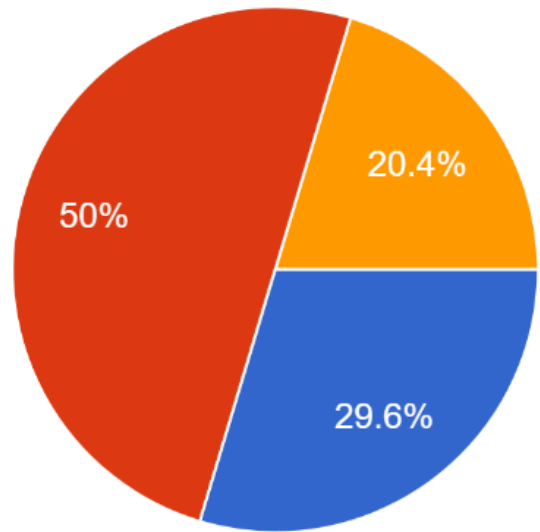


- What fun! The idea intrigues you—you immediately try to think like a sea creature.

54 responses

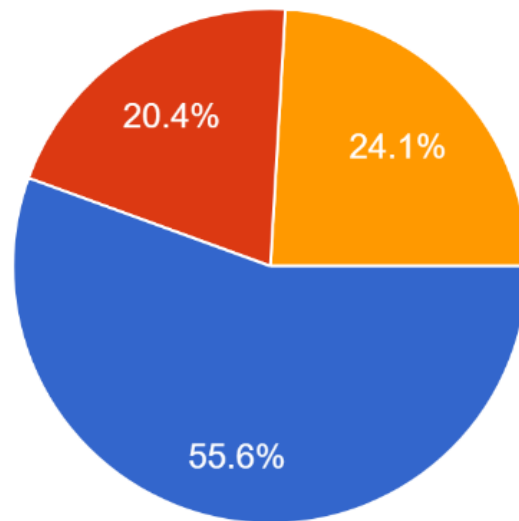


- You leave yourself plenty of time and take a new route. Getting a little lost can be so refreshing!

54 responses

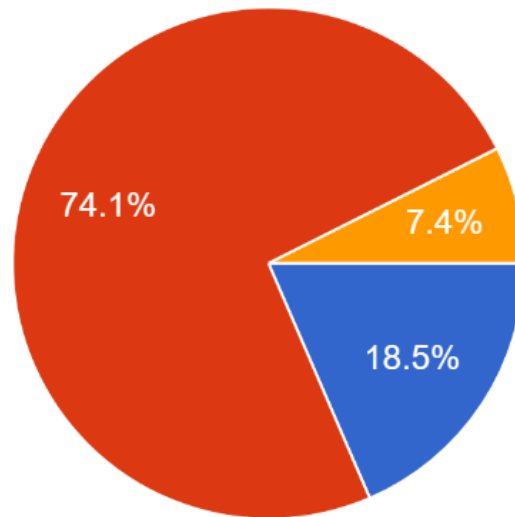


- You follow a familiar recipe exactly.

54 responses

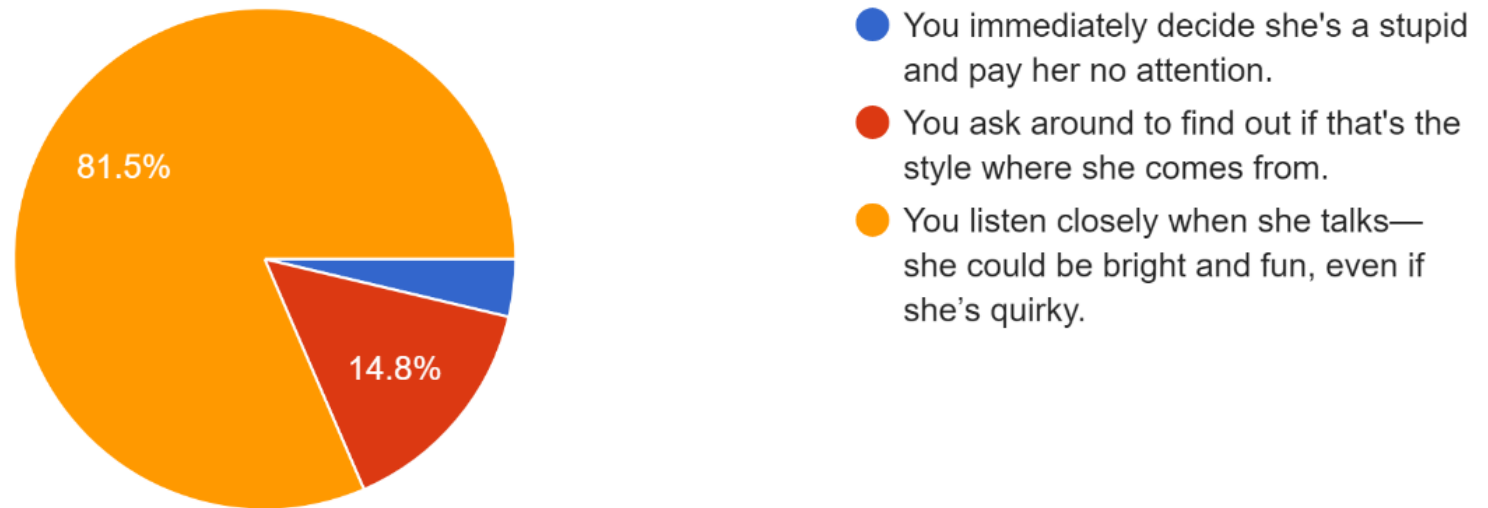


- You rush by the weirder paintings, asking yourself, "What the heck was that artist thinking?"

54 responses

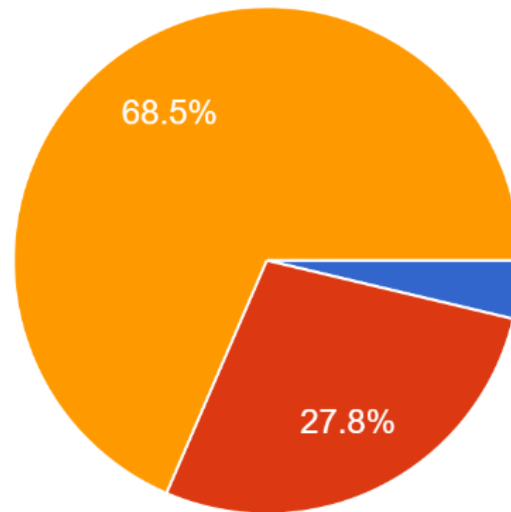


**The vast majority replies that they would listen closely while she talks, the rest would ask around about her and only a few would decide she is stupid and pay her no attention.**

54 responses

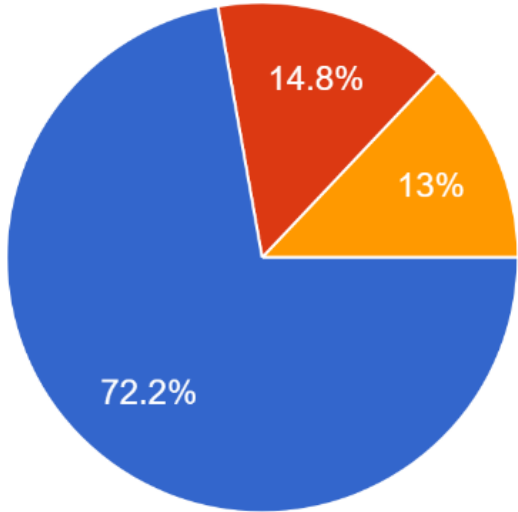


- You shove it in the closet—you have absolutely no use for such a thing.

54 responses

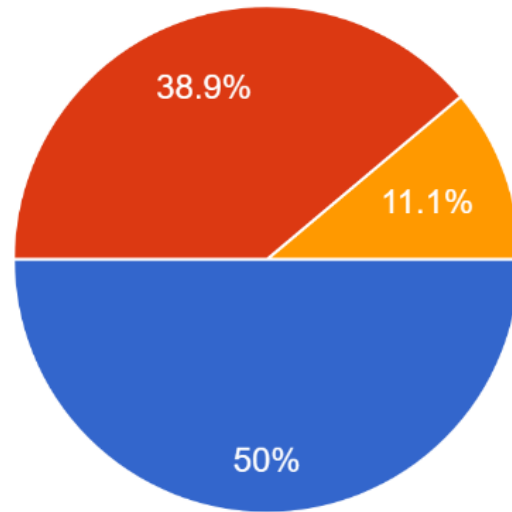


- You suggest the entire family get to know each other better by visiting local spots this year.

12. You watched a film with an uncertain ending: maybe the heroine marries the guy or else she might go off on her own.

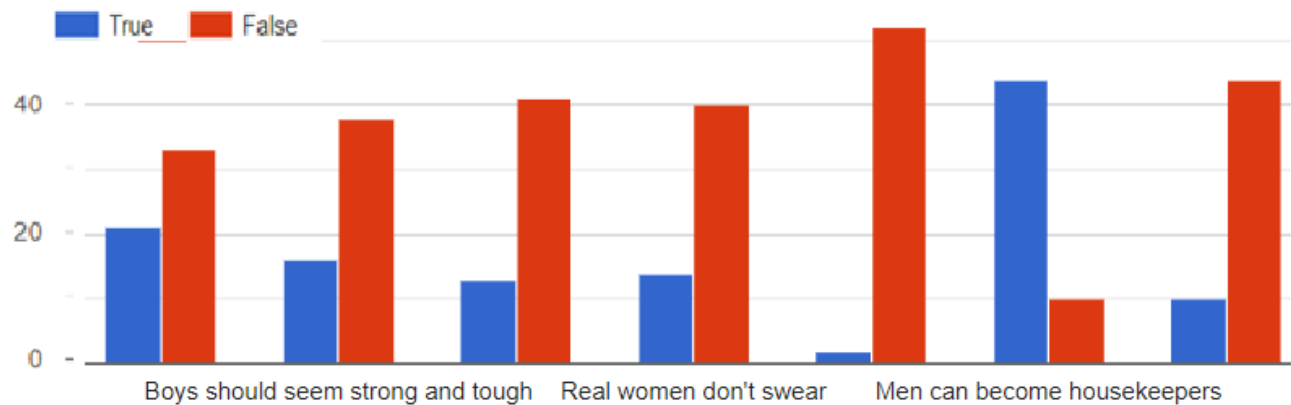
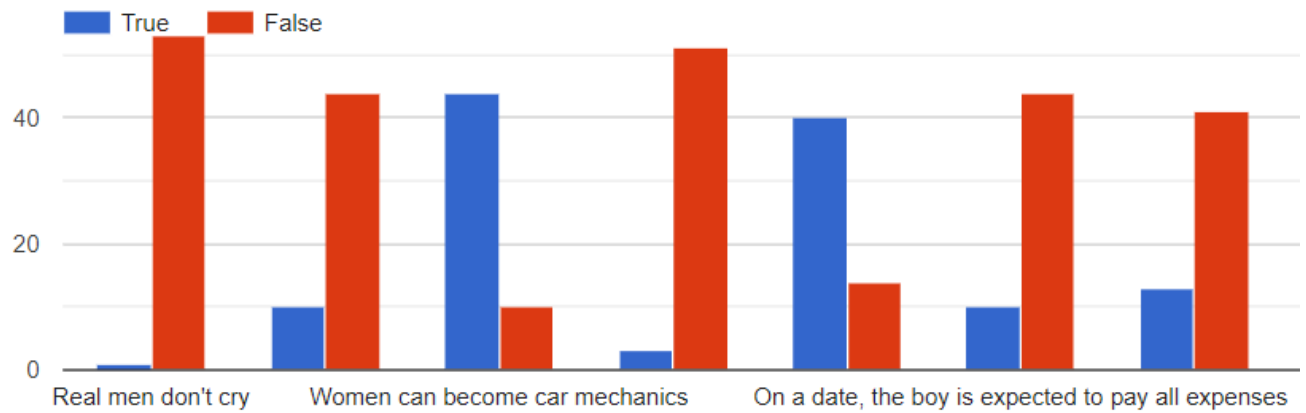
54 responses

13. For each of the following statements, indicate what IN YOUR OPINION is "true" or "false", by checking the corresponding box.

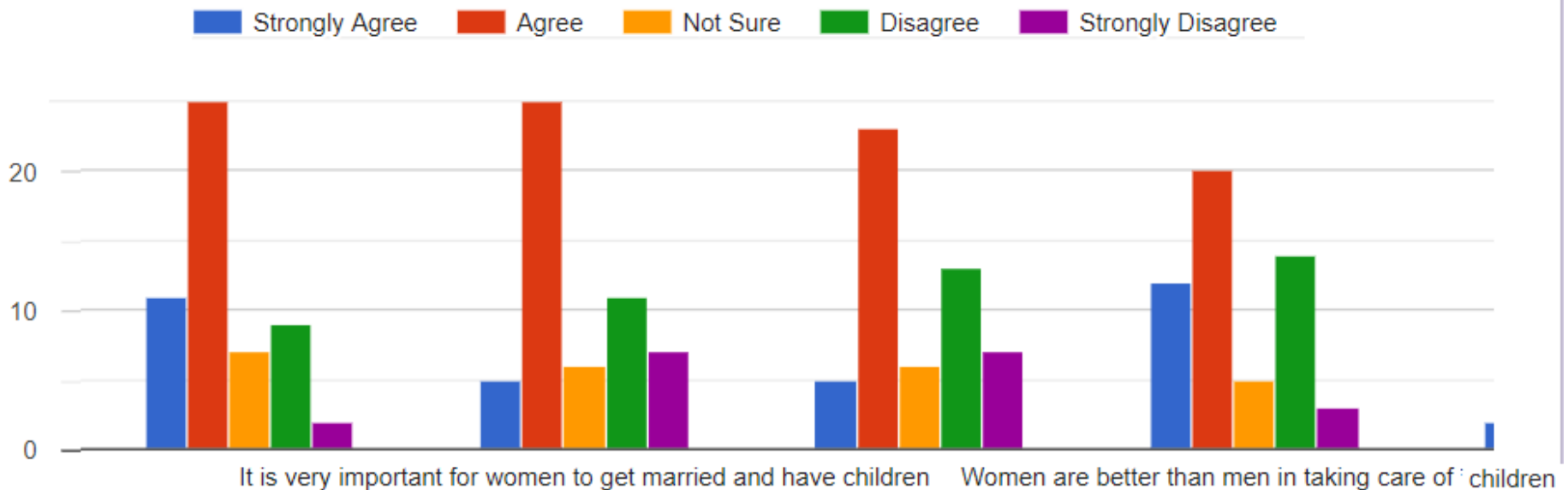
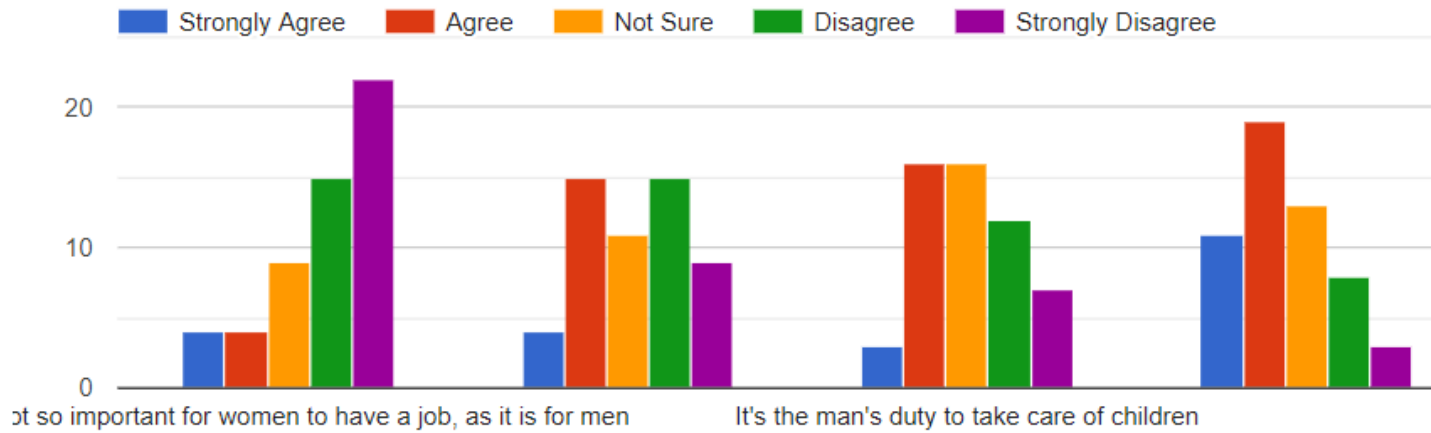

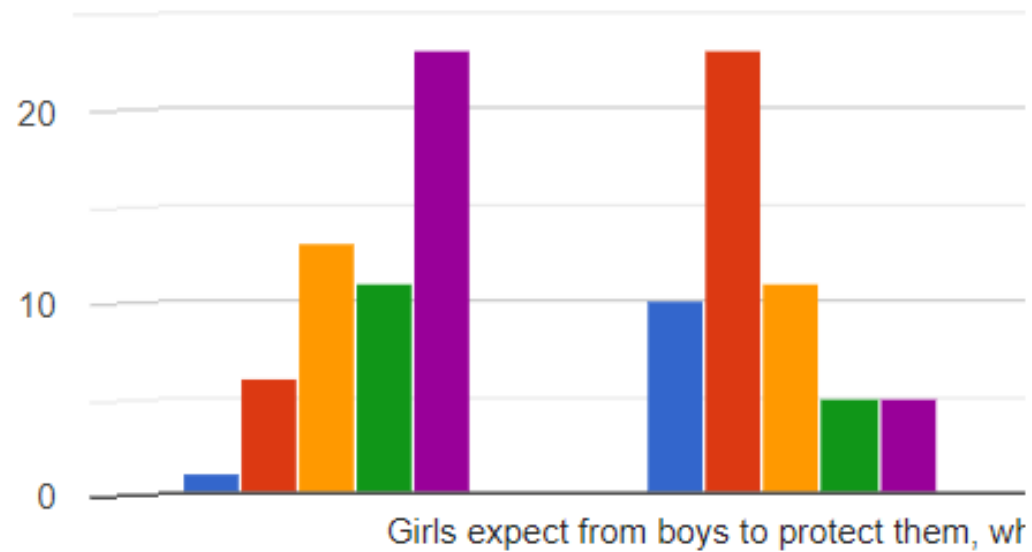
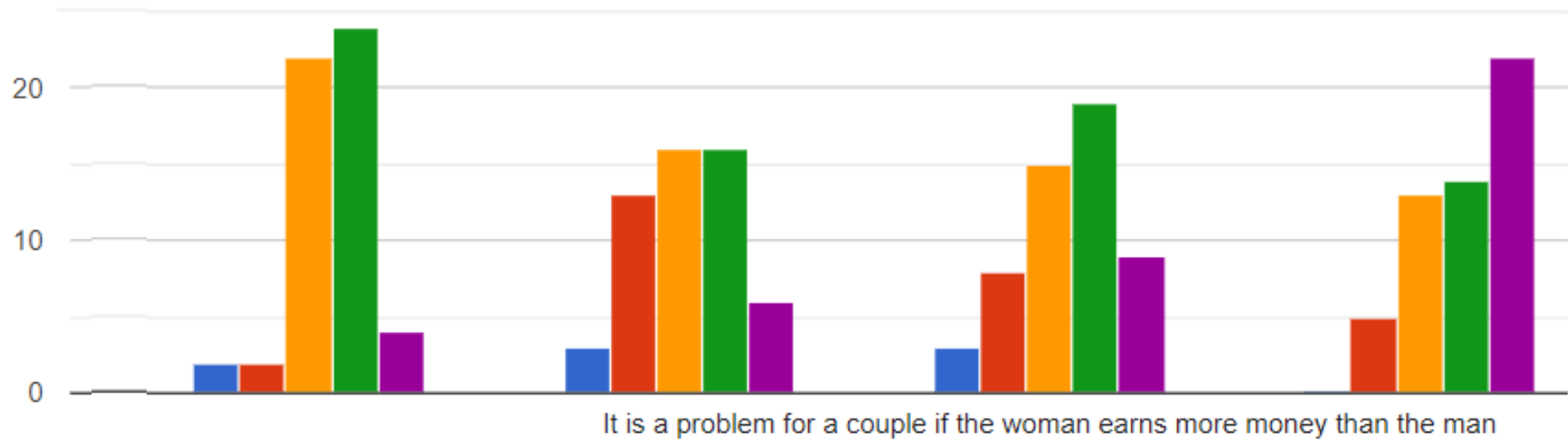


**Most also said that it is false that a girl is expected to pay on a date and that girls should seem weak and sensitive.**

# 14. Rate to what extent you agree or disagree with the following statements, by checking the response that best describes YOUR OWN



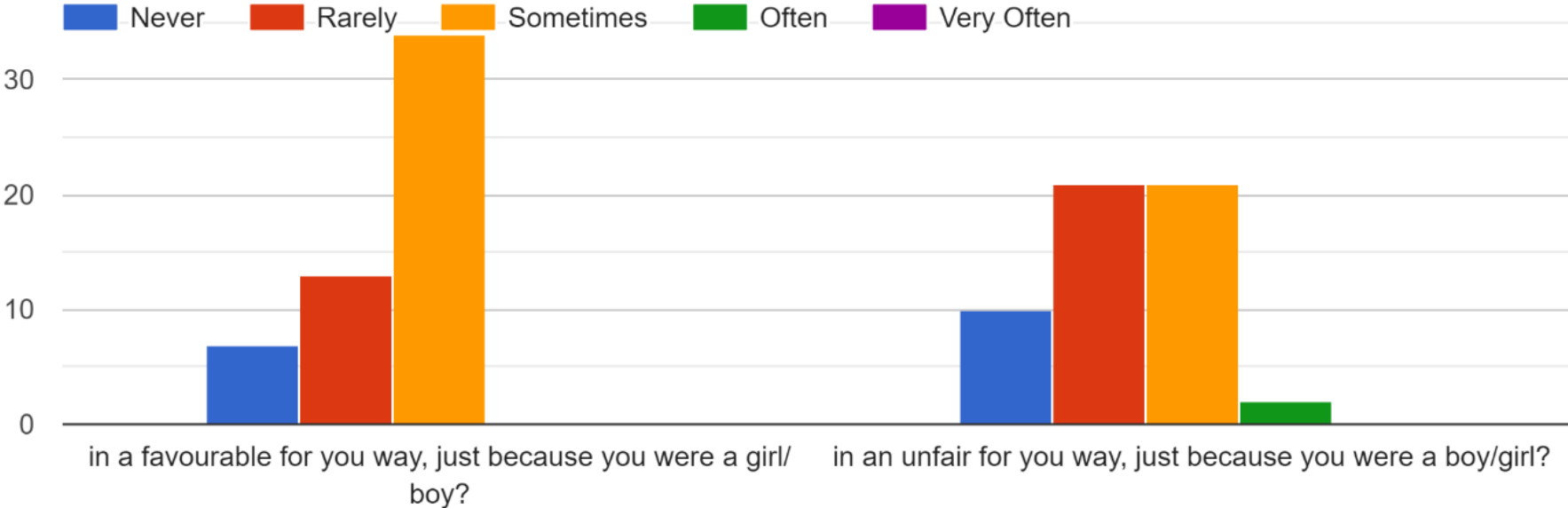
Strongly Agree Agree Not Sure Disagree Strongly Disagree

On another hand, they also agree that it is very important for a woman to get married and have children and that they are better for taking care of said children, however they also agree that it also the man’s duty to take care of the kids.

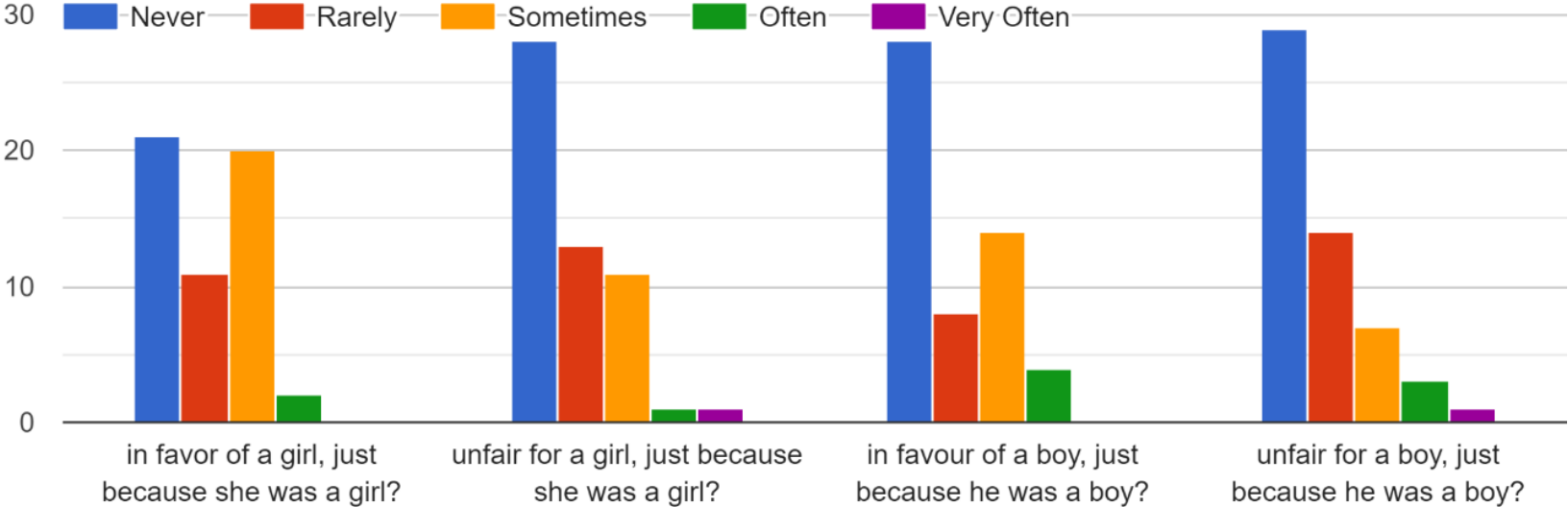
### 15. Has anybody ever behaved or spoken to you:





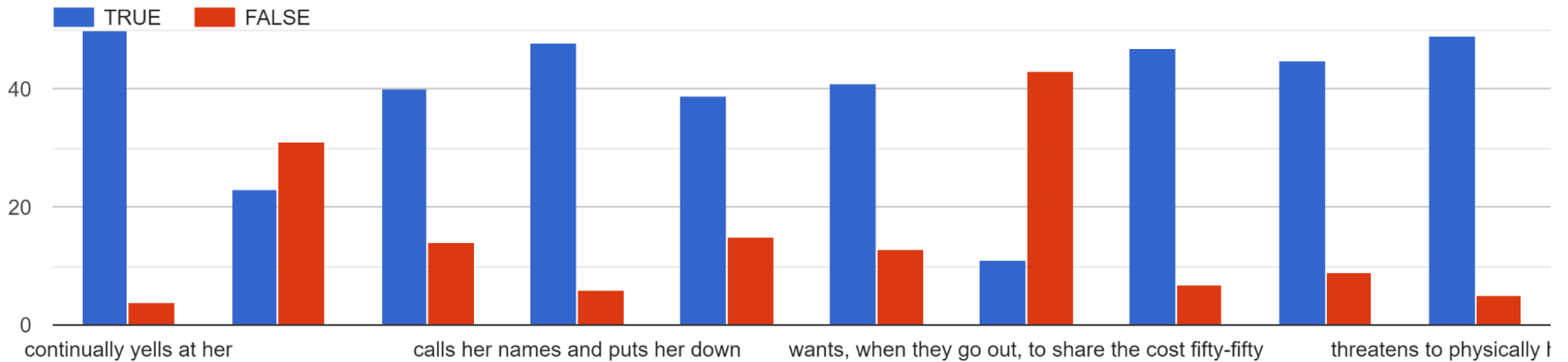
**Most say that people rarely or sometimes behave in favourable way or an unfair way because of their gender.**

16. Have you ever behaved, spoken or thought in a way that was:

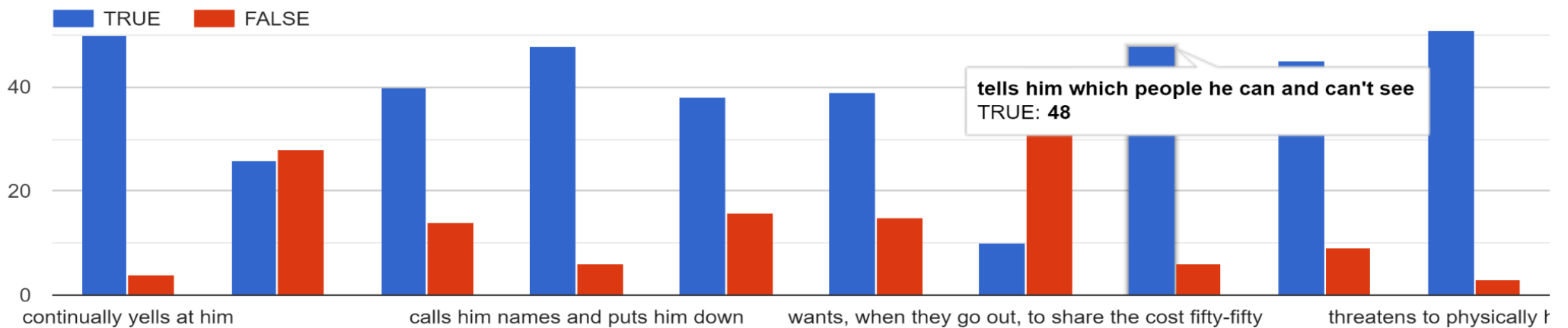

17. It is a type of violence when, in a relationship, HE:

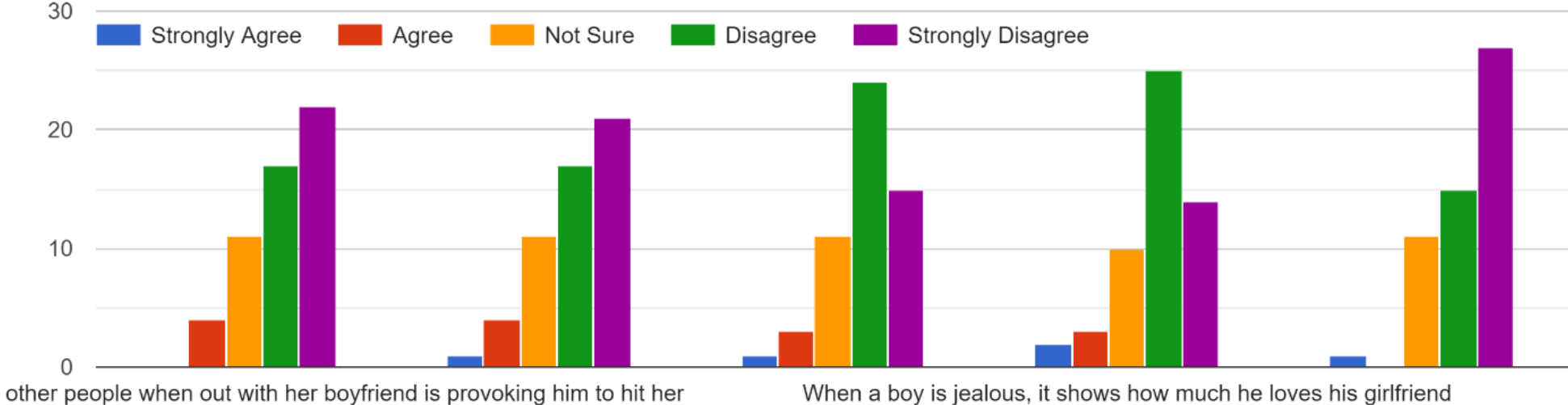


18. It is a type of violence when, in a relationship, SHE:
